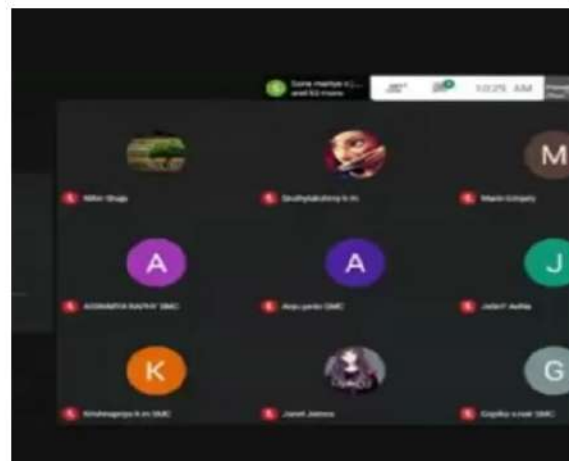

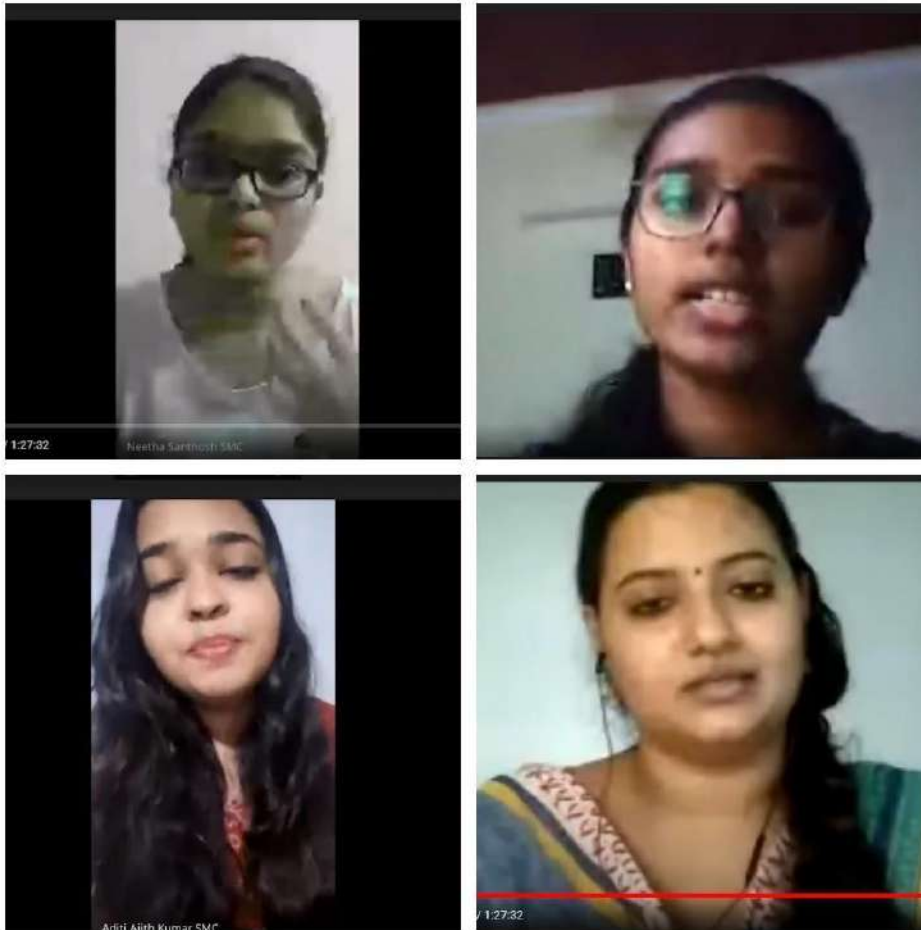
REPORT ON INVITED LECTURE ON CAPITAL MARKET SPONSORED BY BSE

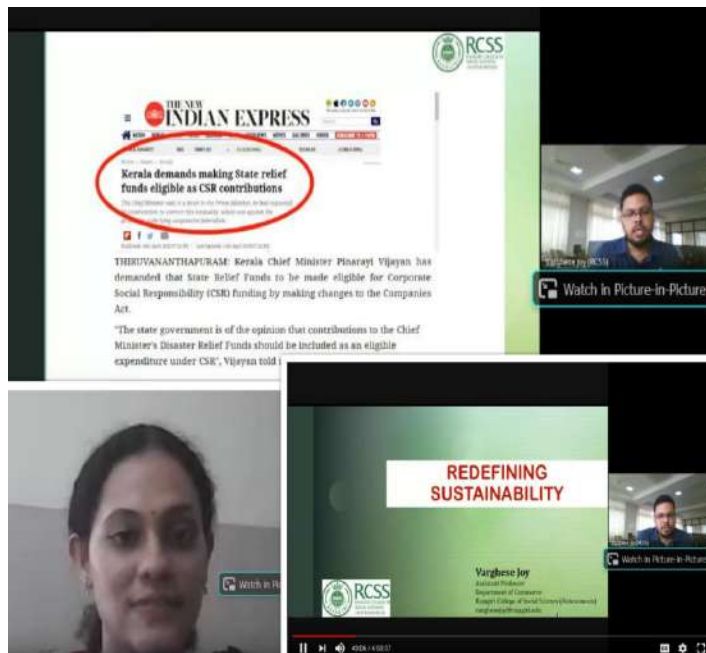

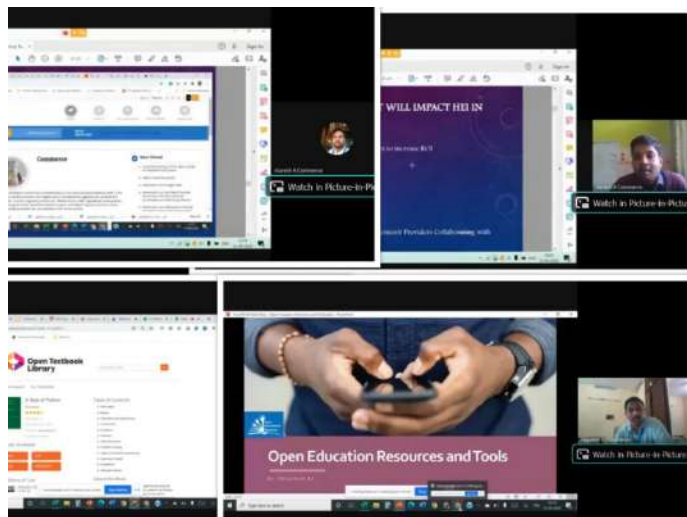
REPORT ON NATIONAL WEBINAR ON “ACADEMIC LITERACY AND OPEN SOURCE TOOLS”

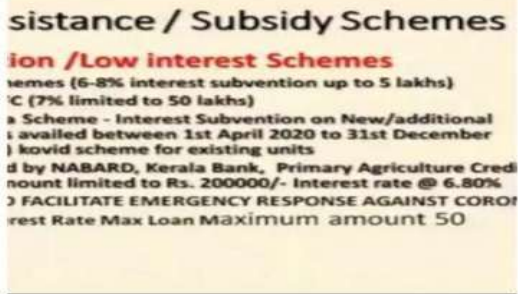

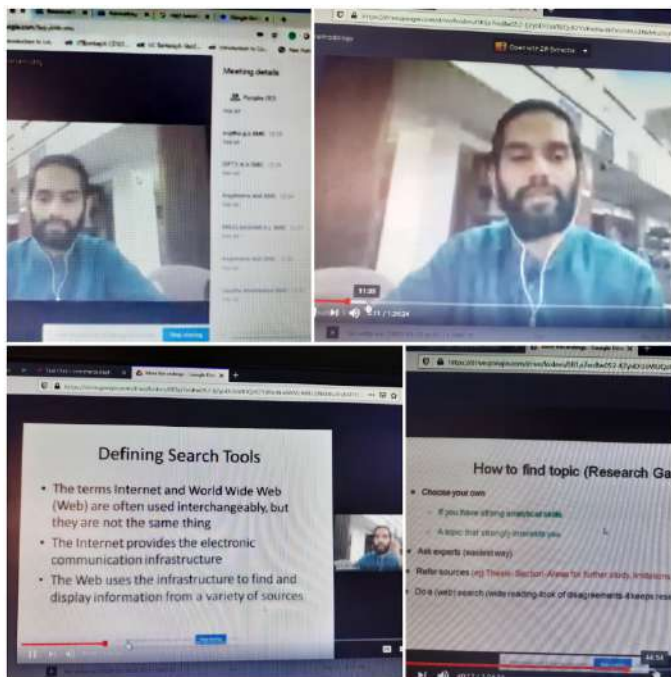

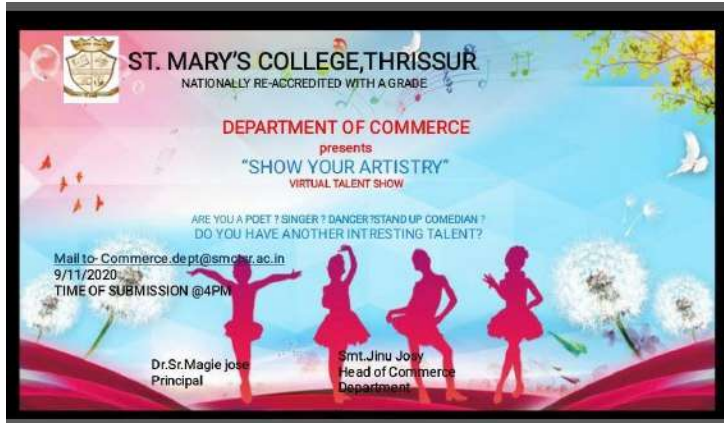
REPORT ON “SHOW US YOUR ARTISTRY”

The Commerce department organised a virtual Product launch activity for the 1st DC B.Com students as a part of the activities organised in connection with the student induction programmes

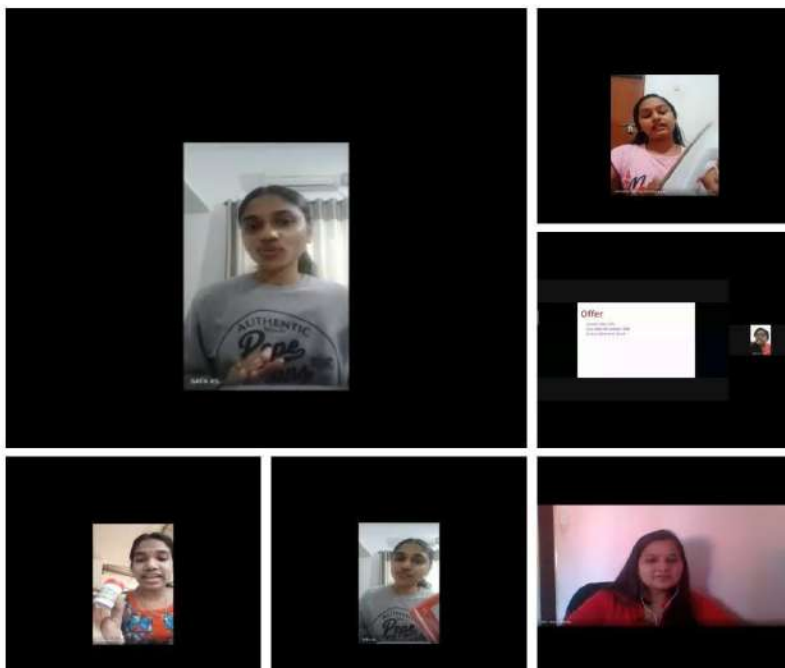

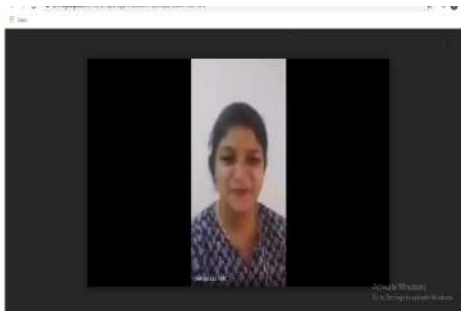
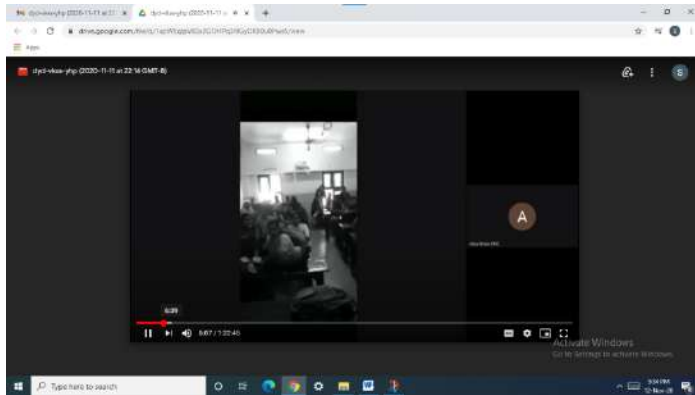
QUERENUA 2020

COMMERCE QUIZZARDS

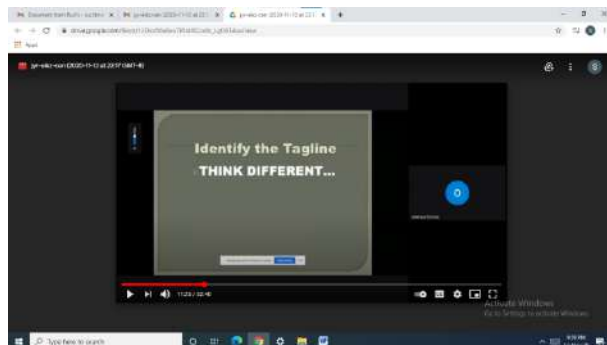

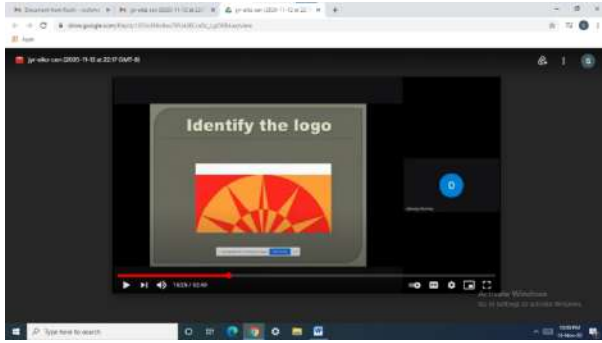
The quiz was arranged for the 1st year B.Com students as a part of their induction programme.

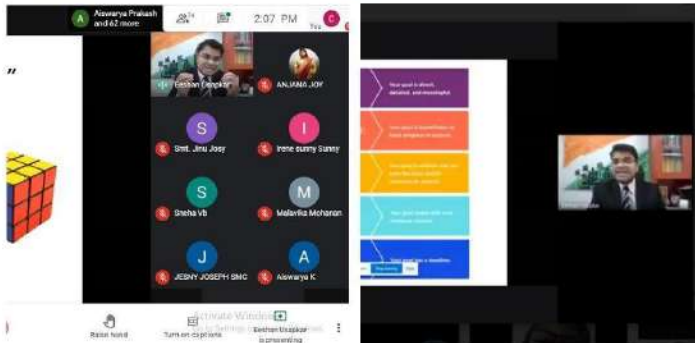
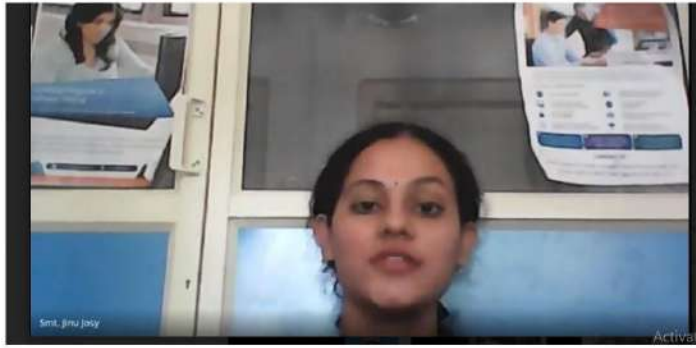


REPORT ON INVITED LECTURE BY ADV.EESHAN USAPKAR

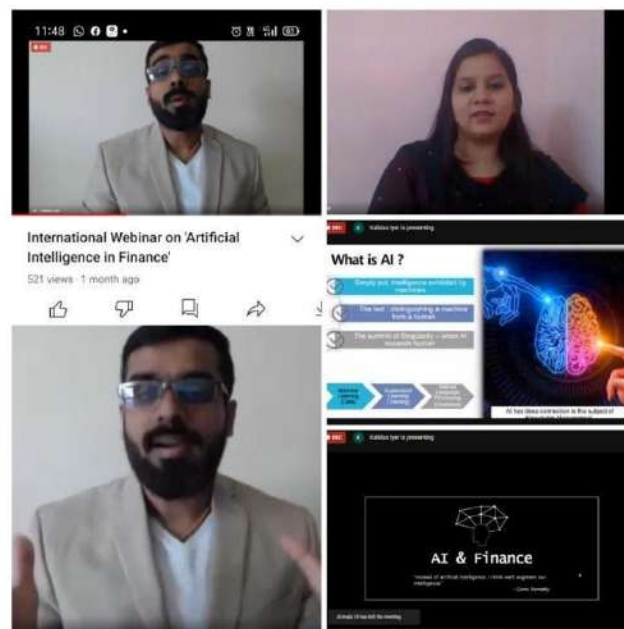


INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR ON ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN FINANCE

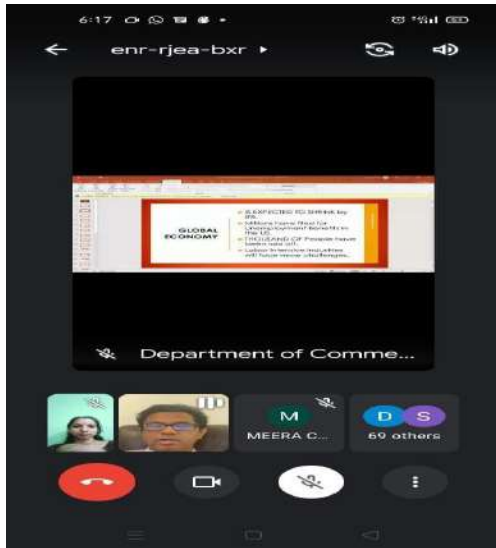

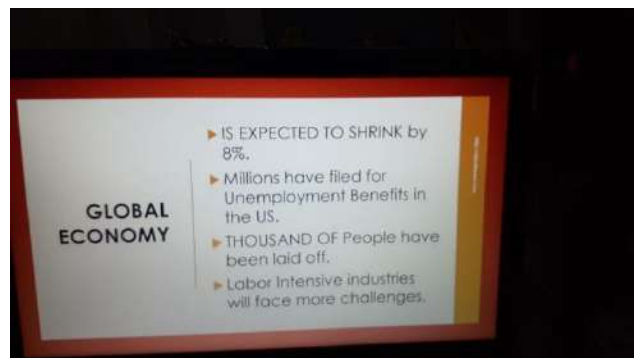
