### **TRIP TO KODAIKANAL**

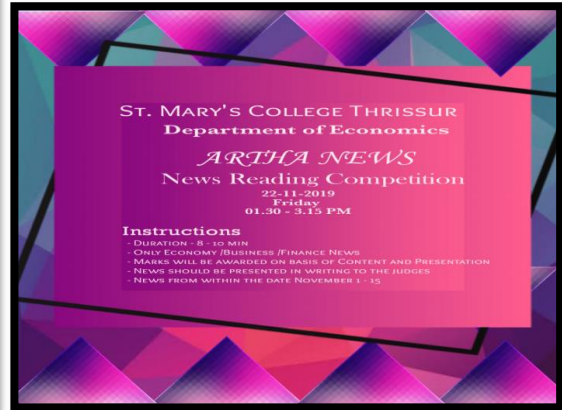
A Trip was arranged for II MA Economics students to Kodaikanal on 31<sup>st</sup> October. Students presented a report on the Tourism in Kodaikanal.
