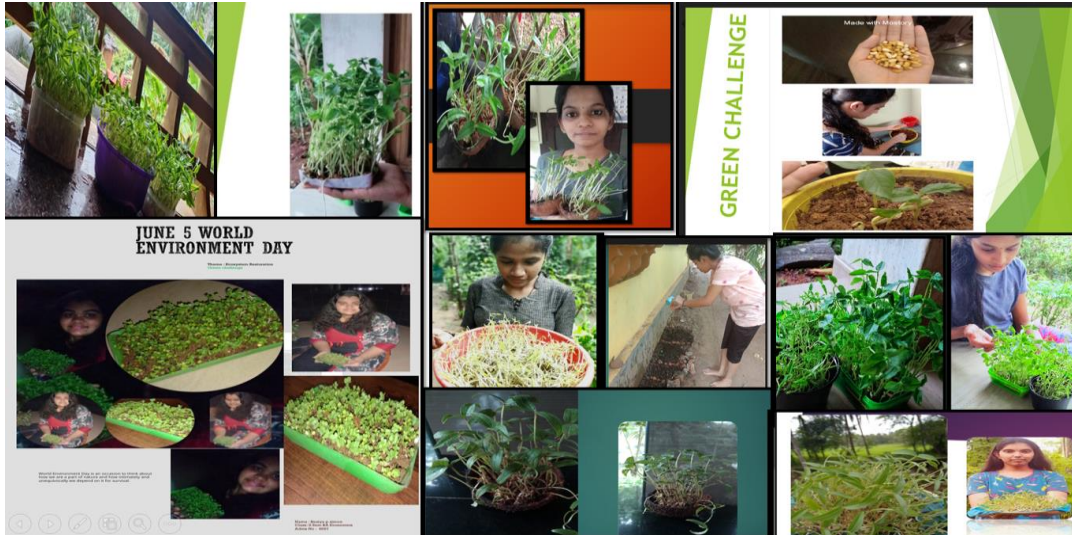

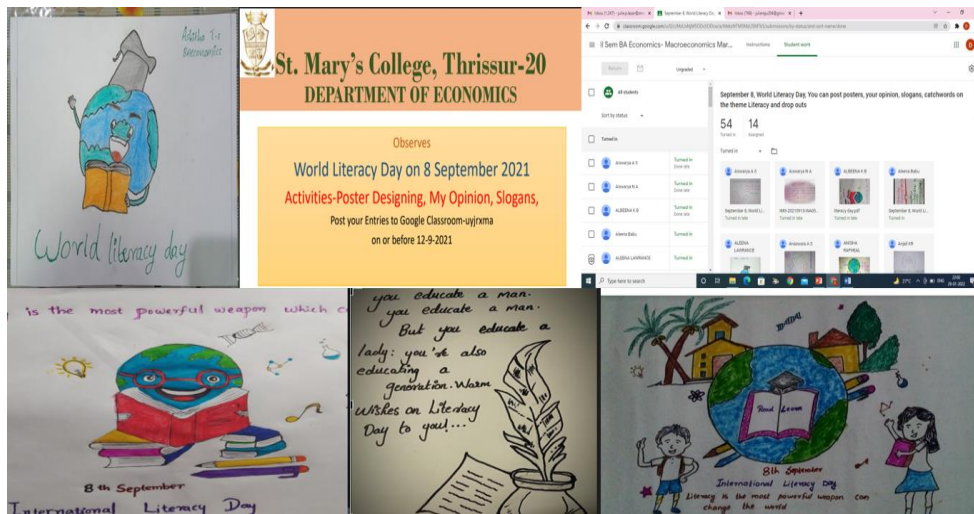
Talk on Basics of Research Methodology

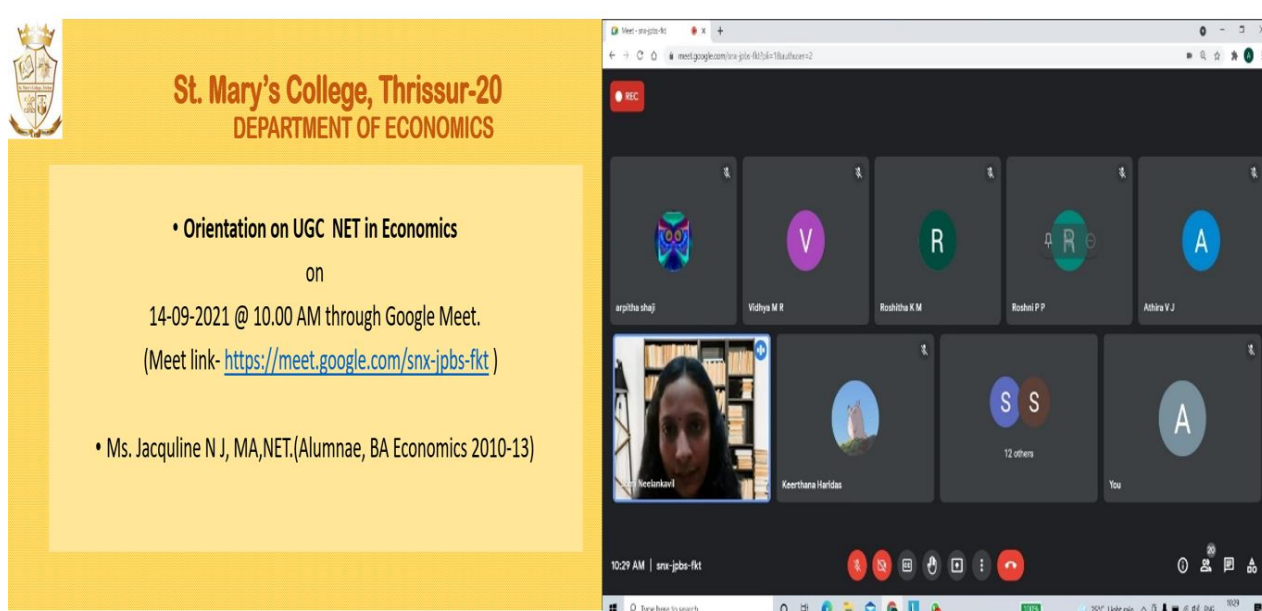
World Literacy Day

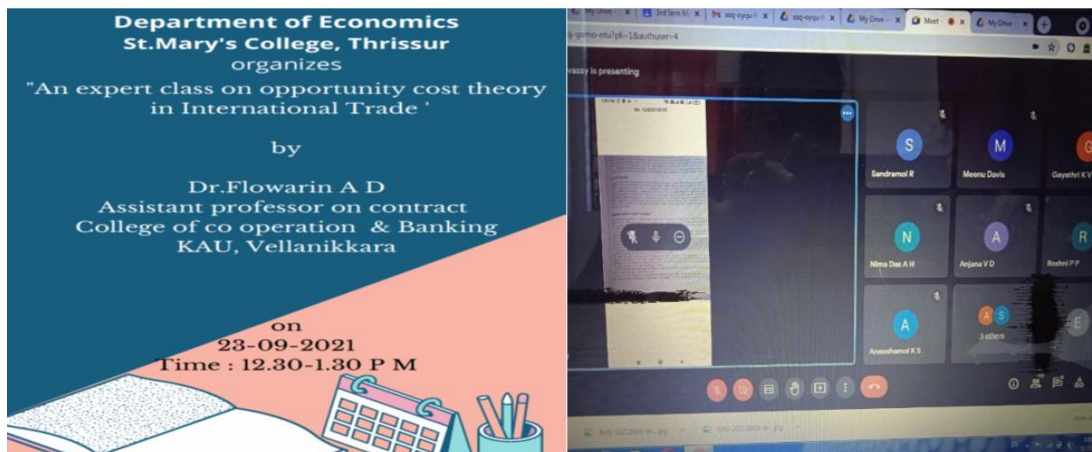
Session on UGC NET in Economics

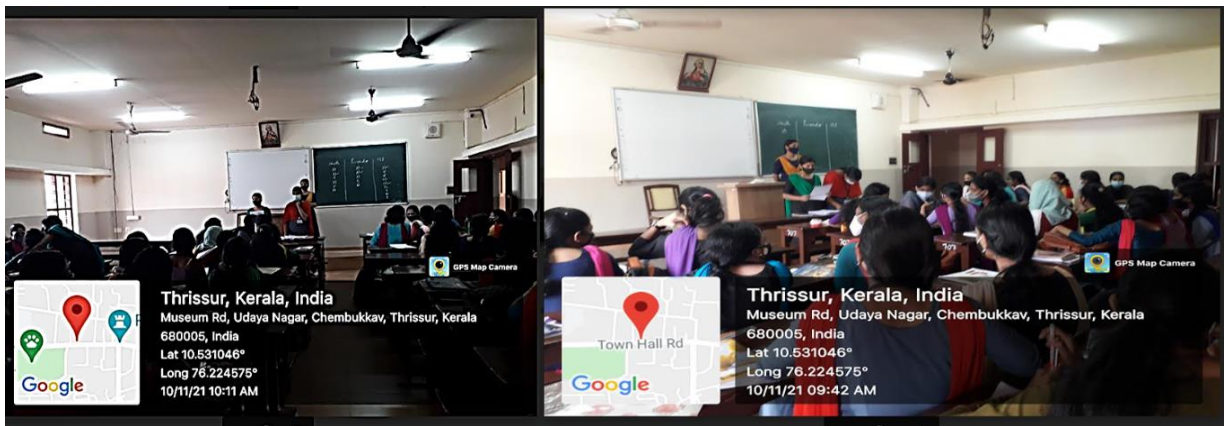

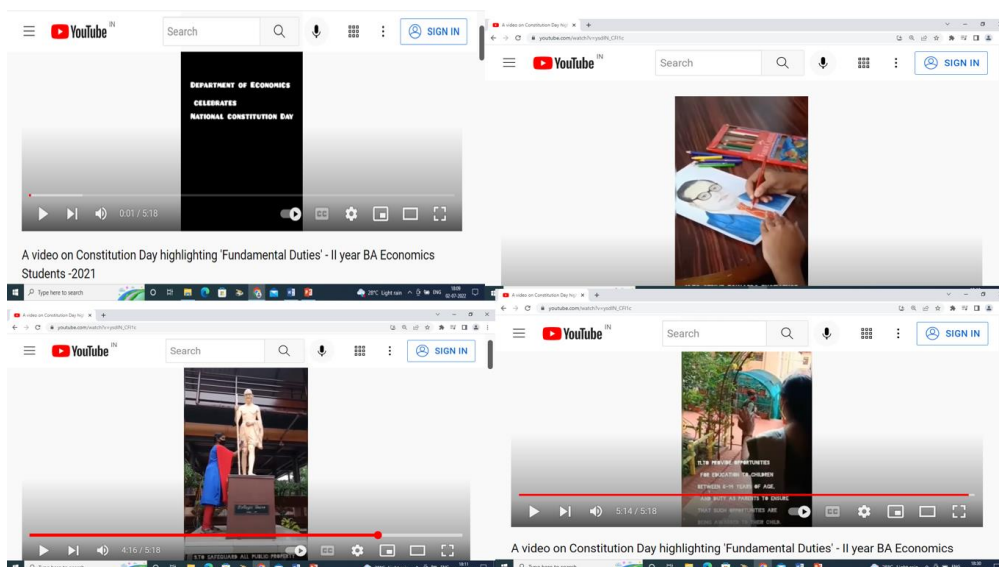
Kerala Piravi

Human Rights Day

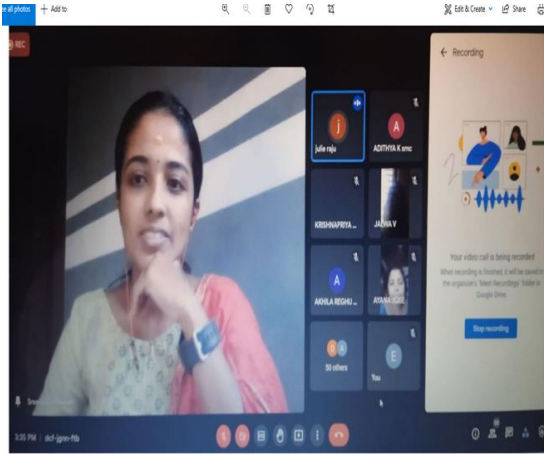
