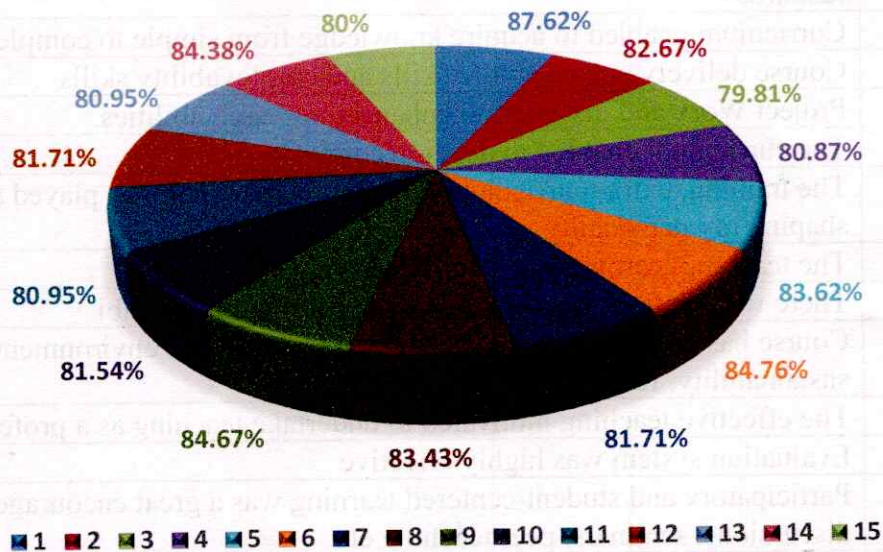
Alumnae Feedback on Curriculum (2022-2023)

Respondent Group – Pass out batches of UG and PG

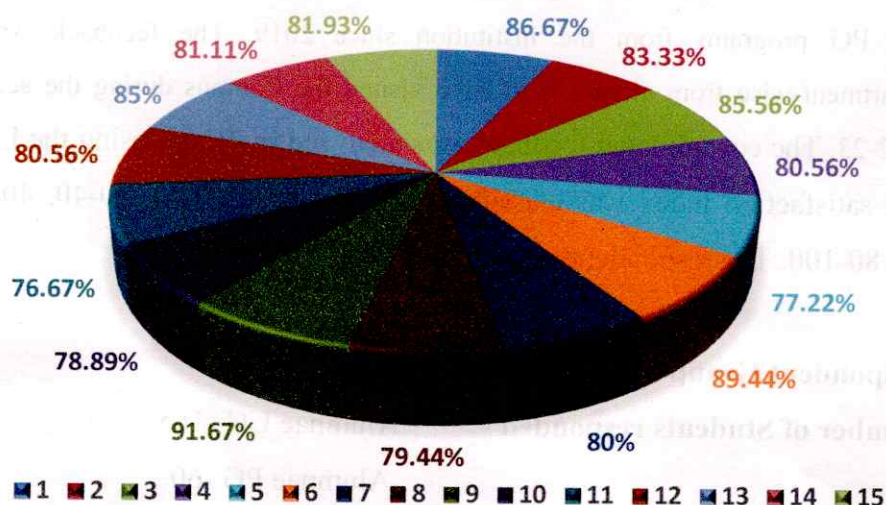
Number of Students responded - Alumnae UG -165
