


### 2. Webinar on 'Introduction to Affiliate Marketing'









## 3. Webinar on "Online Predators And Hackers Targeting Youth"








#### 4. WEBINAR ON NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY(NEP)





## 5. "Flora"- Digital Pookalam Making Competition



/answer session. Over 100 participants from different institutions participated in the webinar and the session successfully came to an end at 10:00 a.m.






#### 7. Q'ZOID 4.0







## 10.Invited Lecture on the topic 'WOMEN SAFETY & CYBER CRIME'
