#### Walk With Scholar (WWS) Programme

Walk With Scholar (WWS) scheme proposes to arrange specialized mentoring programs for students in Under Graduate Programs in Arts, Science and Commerce and to provide guidance and orientation to prepare themselves for employment or select areas for higher study. The scheme introduces the idea of mentoring and builds on the concept of mentor as a 'Guide' and 'Friend'. The mentoring scheme for students will be purely voluntary in nature. The Scheme aims at giving necessary orientation to needy students, to prepare them for employment and give them necessary guidance, motivation and necessary mental support to identify appropriate areas for higher study as well as employment. The mentoring scheme is planned to identify the opportunities available for the scholars, the areas suitable for them, the manner in which the scholar should proceed before them and evolve ways by which they can be acquired. For the purpose of mentoring, two categories of mentors will be identified. One will be 'Internal Mentor' and the second will be 'External Mentor'.

To have a preventive measure on mosquitoes the mentor developed a simple formulation for repelling mosquitoes using medicinal plants. The formulation has been taught to mentees and they tried it for their use. This can be made available for them as well as for the community.





#### **Report of Motivational Visit**

Place of Visit: IISR & IIM Calicut Date:04/03/2017







We started our journey from college at 7.30am .Our group includes three teachers (Dr.Bincy, Smt.Liji & Smt. Vandana) and thirty students (11DC).. IISR is an autonomous organization engaged in agricultural research related to spices in India. The institute has its headquarters in Moozhikkal, Silver Hills, Kozhikode, Kerala and is a subsidiary of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi, under the Ministry of Agriculture, India. The Institute provides research facilities related to spice crops, both Institute funded and externally funded. IISR provides facilities for research and project based education at Masters and PhD levels. It has a range of full-fledged laboratories Centralized Molecular Biology lab, Biochemistry laboratory, Soil Chemistry lab, Plant Protection lab, GCMS facility, Biocontrol laboratory, IISR has an extensive facility called the National Informatics Centre on Spices (NICS), which maintains global scientific literature, e-journals, offline and online databases, Internet connectivity and data storage facility. After a small video session on IISR by Dr.P Rajeev, Principal Scientist.
